

Two Techniques in One - Topaz (revised)

Instructor: Linda Sullivan of Colourwerx Full Day Workshop

Workshop Descriptive: Learn the beginning basics of foundation piecing plus refine your precision piecing skills with this '2 technique in one' workshop while making this stunning quilt. Linda will guide students step by step and demo her time tested, stress free tips and tricks for paper piecing and for perfect precision piecing! There are 2 different blocks we will make in class - students should choose concentrate on making several pieced blocks and atl least (1) fully paper pieced block in the workshop.



MATERIALS NEEDED:

Pattern: Topaz Patten CW-133 by Colourwerx

(A complimentary pattern will be given to each student at the workshop)

Fabric Requirements for the Workshop:

These fabric requirements are the minimum needed for class which will make (4) Pieced Blocks and (4) Paper Pieced Blocks. This can finish into a nice table runner. Start by choosing (2) colors (i.e.: green and yellow) that are compliementary to each other and then select several different tones or values in those (2) colors. If you are planning on making the Lap Size quilt (pictured above), please refer to page 3 of the supply list.

Refer to diagram at right -

- 1. Block A (Paper Pieced Block with Pinwheel): for (4) blocks -
 - a. Pinwheel Fabrics (choose 2 fabrics): 1/4 yard each fabric
 - b. Background Fabric (black in photo) 1/2 yard
 - c. Colored Fabric (greens in photo) (choose 2 fabrics):
 - Dark Value 1/3 yard
 - Light Value 3/8 yard (13.5")


2. Block B - (Square in a Square): - for (4) blocks --


- a. Background Fabric (white in Photo) 1/4 yard
- c. Colored Fabric (yellows in photo) (choose 2 fabrics):
 - Dark Value 1/4 yard
 - Light Value 1/2 yard

You will also need these other sewing items to complete this project:

- 1. (1) Pack Carol Doak Legal Size Foundation paper
- 2. Sewing Machine in good working condition please bring your manual, cord, foot pedal and presser feet
- 3. 1/4" Piecing Presser Foot for your sewing machine
- 4. 100% Cotton 50 weight Neutral Color Thread for Piecing (Aurifil 50 weight preferred)
- 5. Schmetz 75/11 Sewing Machine Quilting Needles
- 6. Basic Sewing Supplies such as: fine glasshead quilting straight pins, scissors, marking pencil or pen; seam ripper, etc...

Before Class --

Please prepare and precut the following from your fabrics:

1. <u>Print Paper Piecing Templates:</u> Download the Paper Piecing Template from the Colourwerx website at: https://colourwerx.com/pages/topaz-paper-piecing-template

Making sure your printer is set to print on Legal Size paper and at 100% scale and NOT Scale to Fit, print out at least (16) copies of the template on the Carol Doal Legal Size Paper Piecing Paper.

- 2. Precut Fabrics and label to keep organized:
- 1. Block A (Paper Pieced Block with Pinwheel): for (4) blocks -
 - a. Pinwheel Fabrics (label A & B) 2 fabrics 1/4 yard each fabric cut the following from each fabric:
 - (3) 3" x WOF strips subcut into (16) 3" x 6-1/2" strips
 - b. Background Fabric (label C) (black in photo) 1/2 yard cut the following:
 - (4) 4" x WOF strips; subcut into (32) 4" x 4" squares
 - c. Colored Fabric (greens in photo) (choose 2 fabrics):
 - Dark Value (label H) 1/3 yard cut the following:
 - (2) 5" x WOF strips; subcut into (15) 5" x 5" squares
 - Light Value (label G) 3/8 yard (13.5") cut the following:
 - (4) 3" x WOF strips; subcut into (16) 3" x 9" strips
- 2. Block B (Square in a Square): for (4) blocks -
 - a. Background Fabric (white in Photo) 1/4 yard cut the following:
 - (1) 5" x WOF strips; subcut into (8) 5" x 5" squares
 - c. Colored Fabric (yellows in photo) (choose 2 fabrics):
 - Dark Value 1/4 yard cut the following:
 - (1) 5" x WOF strips; subcut into (8) 5" x 5" squares
 - Light Value 1/2 yard cut the following:
 - (7) 2-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut into the following units
 - 1. (8) 2-1/2" x 8" strips; and
 - 2. (8) 2-1/2" x 12" strips

BRING ALL OF YOUR REMAINING FABRIC AND THE PRINTED PAPER PIECING PATTERNS TO CLASS.
